The J.L. Cleland GLBT Non-Discrimination Scholarship was established to provide a scholarship to ultimately play a part in reducing and eliminating hatred, bullying, discrimination, bigotry and violence against gay, lesbian, bi-sexual and transgender persons. There will be one \$7,500 scholarship awarded for the 2017-2018 academic year, which may be renewed for up to four years.

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. Applicants must be residents of Kansas and current high school seniors admissible to KU for the fall 2017 term.
- 2. Applicants must have experienced discrimination, bullying and/or violence based on belief that applicant is gay, lesbian, bi-sexual or transgendered.
- 3. Applicants must demonstrate support for GLBT persons.
- 4. One recipient will be offered the J.L. Cleland GLBT Non-Discrimination Scholarship. The recipient will be awarded a \$7,500 scholarship, which may be renewable for a total of four years.

Application Procedure

- 1. Complete, sign and mail the Application Cover Page by February 1, 2017.
- 2. Complete the University of Kansas admissions process at admissions.ku.edu/apply by **February 1, 2017**.

INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

Required Documents

- 1. Application Cover Page.
- 2. A 1-2 page essay demonstrating their commitment to fostering non-discrimination toward GLBT persons and/or to their commitment to and involvement in the GLBT community.
- 3. Please provide contact information of two individual that can serve as a reference check. Individuals may be your guidance counselor, teacher, or a community leader.

Applications will be reviewed by a scholarship committee based on completion of application requirements. <u>Applications and cover page are due February 1, 2017.</u> Applications postmarked after this deadline will not receive consideration for this scholarship. Scholarship recipients will be notified by **March 15, 2017**.
